




Q2 Do you support a 4 day school week?



Q3 If interested in a shortened school week, which day would you like to have off in addition to Saturday and Sunday? Please rank your choices in order of preference.








Q6 If you do currently or would possibly participate in extracurricular activities, would starting or ending practice later than our current times make you less likely to participate in extracurricular activities?

Q7 What is your greatest concern with a possible four day school week?







Q9 When deciding whether to support a modified/shortened school week, how important is childcare availability to you?





Q10 When deciding whether to support a modified/shortened school week, how important is scheduling/vacation flexibility to you?







Q12 When deciding whether to support a modified/shortened school week, how important is personal/family time to you?





Q13 When deciding whether to support a modified/shortened school week, how important is potential learning loss (with regard to student scores on standardized tests) to you?





Q14 When deciding whether to support a modified/shortened school week, how important is potential food insecurity to you?




